

Book of Centuries

Basic instructions:

Print single sided and either 3-hole punch for a binder or have it coil bound.

For an authentic Charlotte Mason Book of Centuries, you need a lined century page facing a blank page, which is why you don't want to print double-sided.

Each lined sheet is divided into 20 rows, with each row being 5 years. Divide the rows visually into 5 sections, or use a light pencil line.

Students should write main events in the appropriate year block. Choose carefully, as this book is meant to follow students through their entire school career.

The blank facing page is for drawings of artifacts from museums, or illustrations from books. I would advise not to use timeline cutouts or stickers. Not only will they make the book unreasonably thick in a short period of time, but the act of drawing or sketching does more to fix things in the mind than cutting out and gluing.

Though the lines are in color, if you are having this printed at an office supply store color printing is prohibitively expensive. Print in black and white and call it done.

The prehistoric period pages should be used for major finds and general notes. These will obviously not have specific dates. You might want to write down human migrations or what animals were walking the earth.

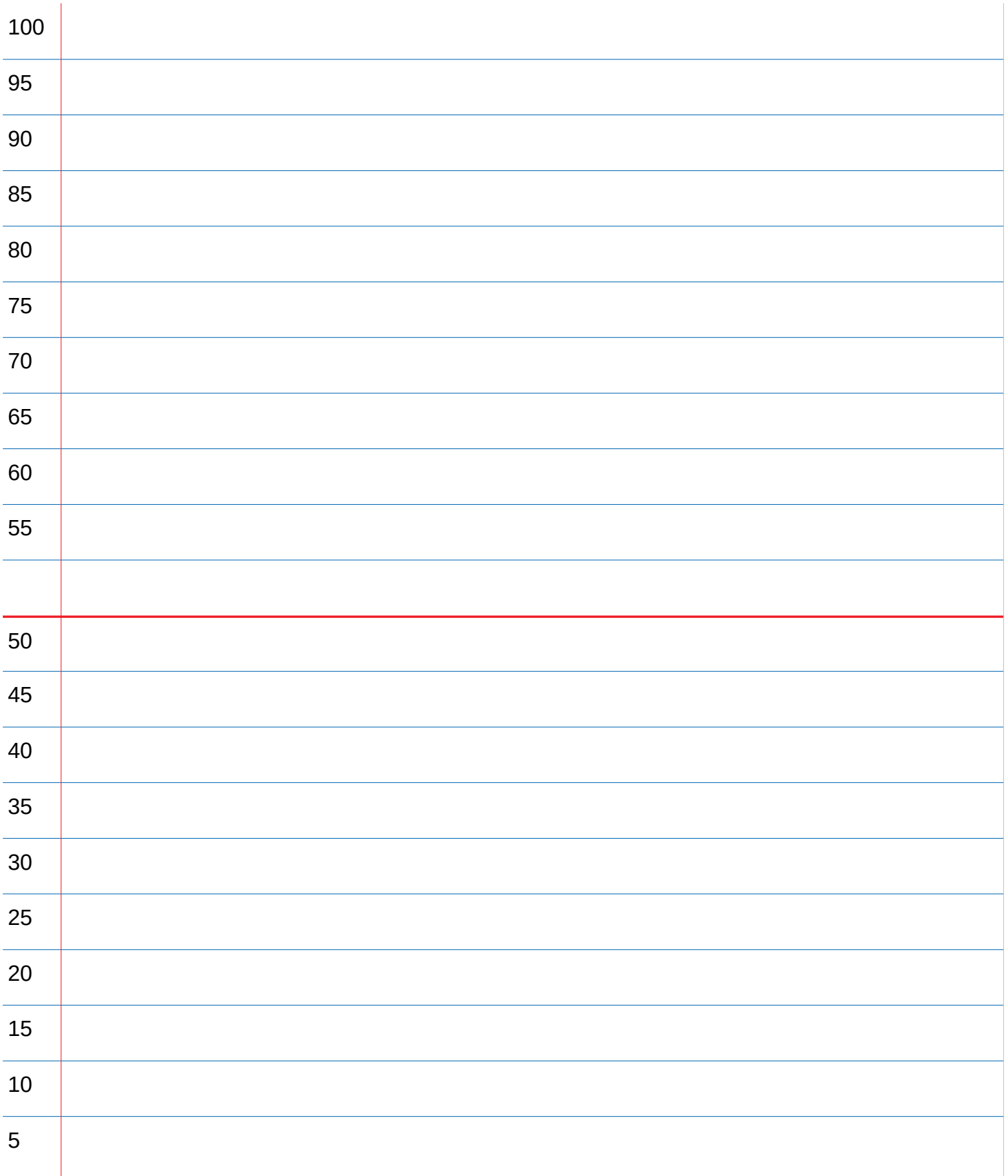

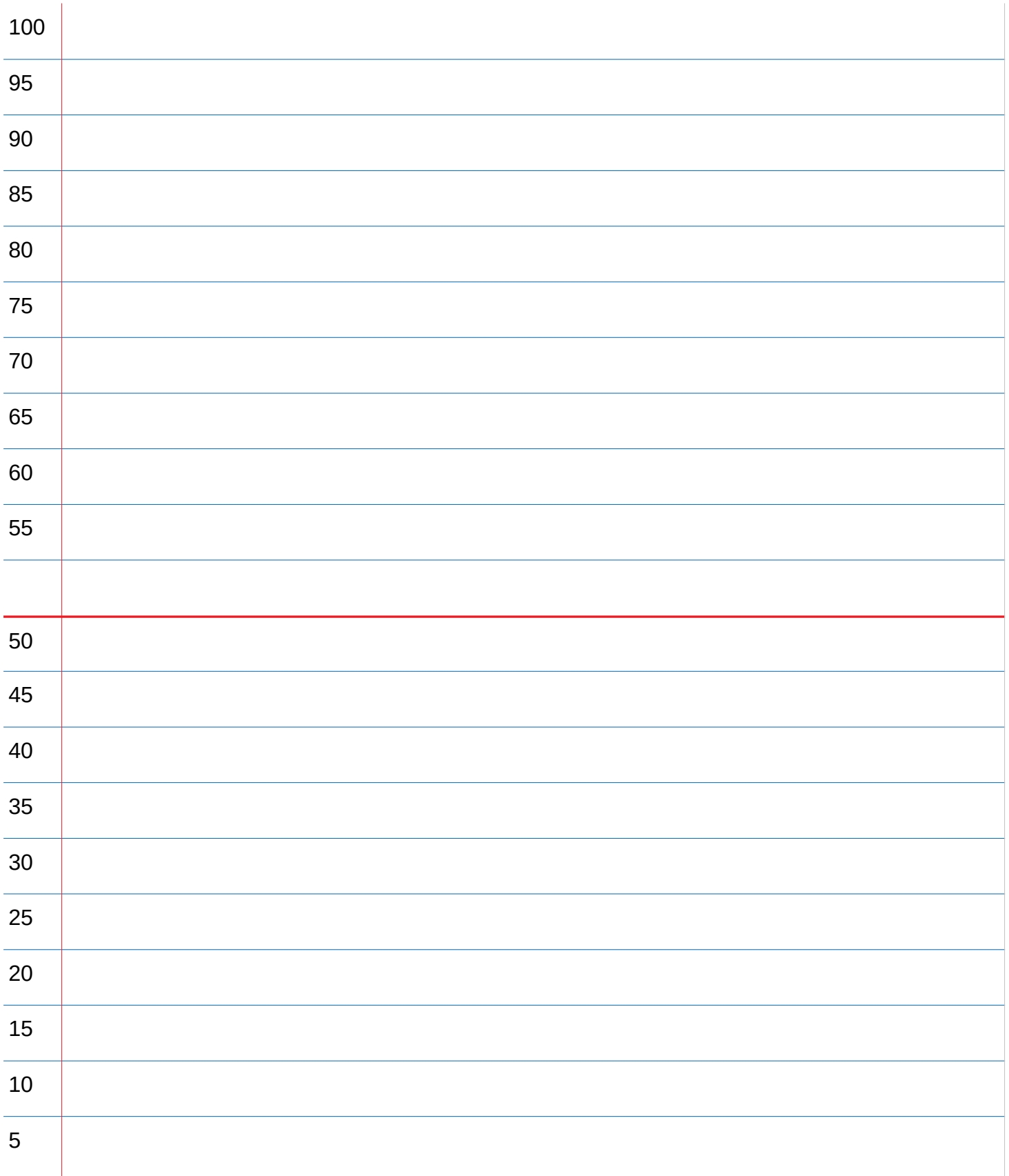

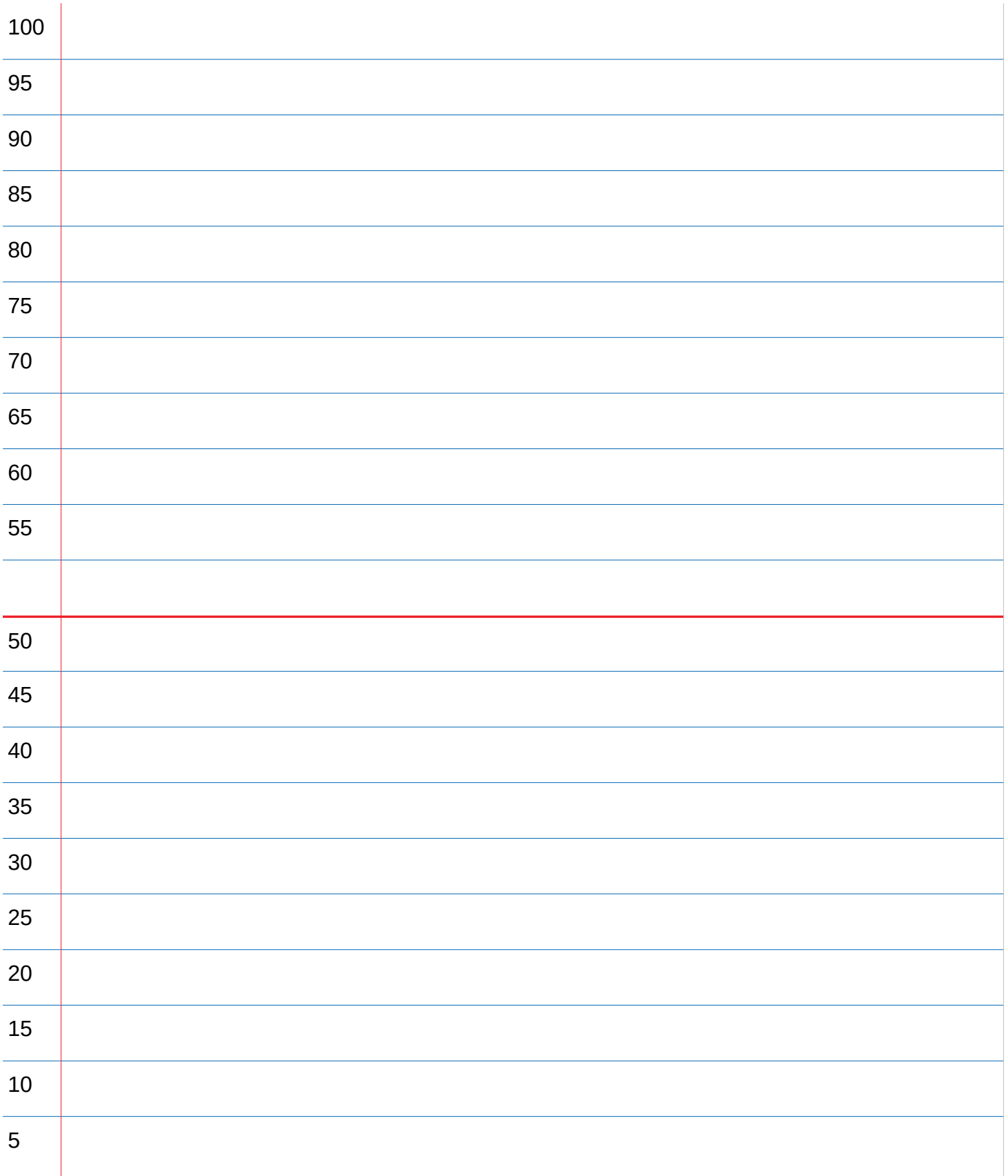
3rd Century BCE 300-201 BCE

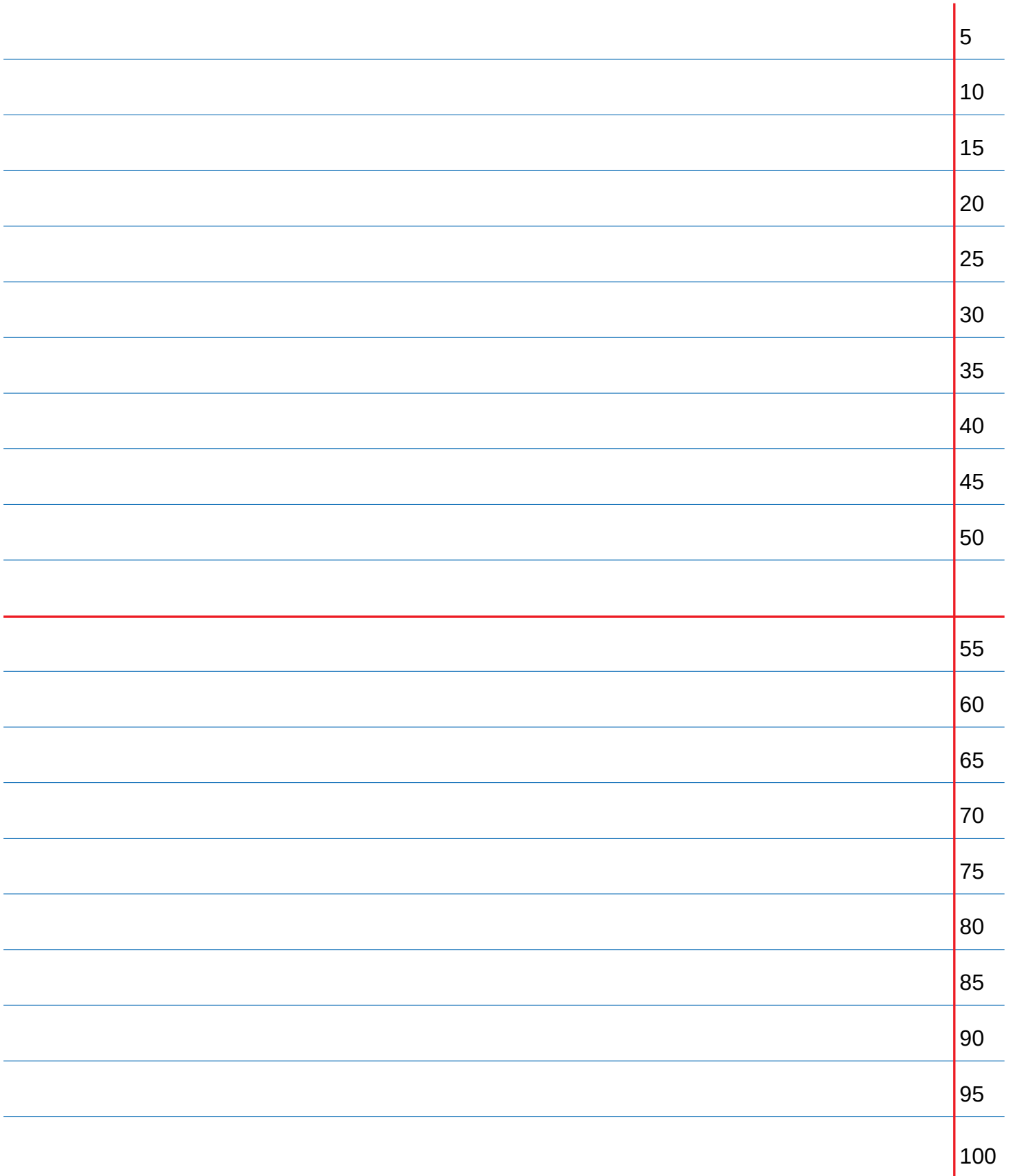

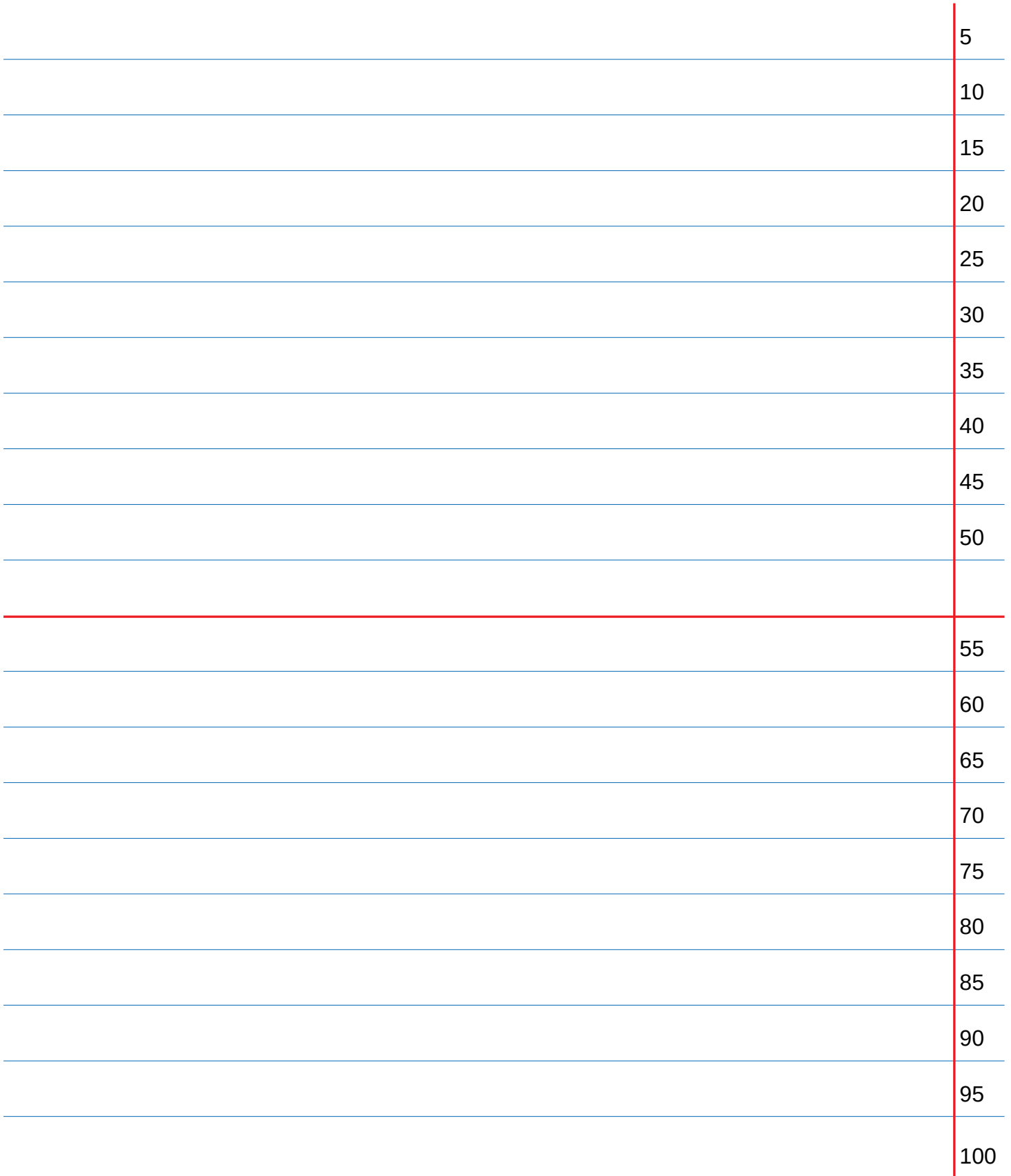

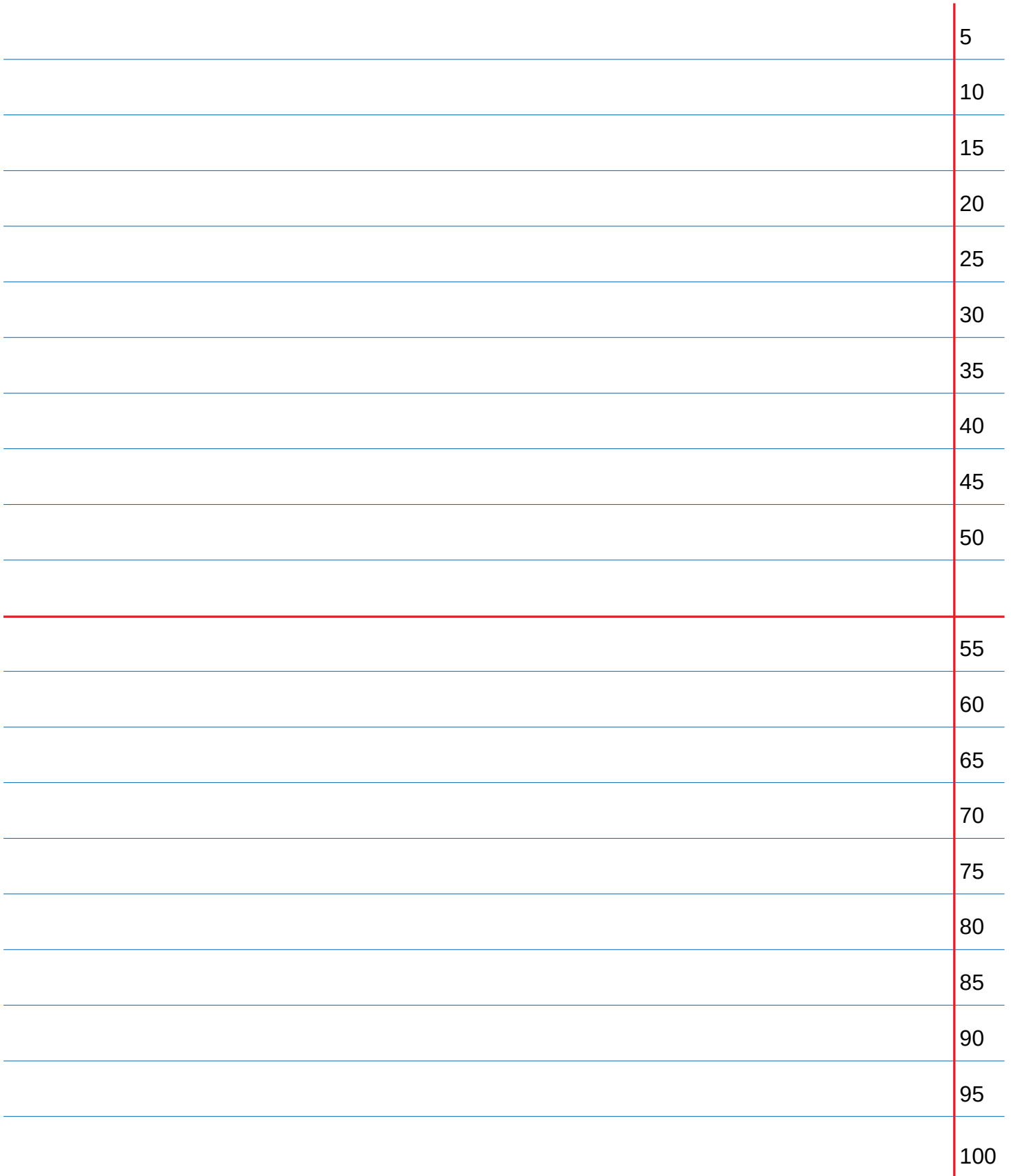
